

Healing Words

Hebrews 13:8 – Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

III John 2 – Beloved, I pray that you may prosper and be in health, just as your soul prospers.

Exodus 15:26 – If you diligently heed the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the Lord who heals you.

Psalms 103:1-3 – Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not **all His benefits**: Who forgives all your iniquities, who heals all your diseases. Who redeems your life from destruction.

Isaiah 53:4-5 – Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we **are** healed.

I Peter 2:24 – Who Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree **that we having died to sins**, might live for righteousness – by whose stripes you were healed.

Matthew 8:16-17 – When evening had come, they had brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick **that it might be fulfilled** which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet saying: He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses.

Healings In Jesus' Ministry

Matthew 8:1-3 – When He had come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed Him, And behold a leper came and worshipped Him saying, “*Lord, if you are willing*, You can make me clean.” Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, “*I am willing*, be cleansed.” Immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Matthew 8:5-7 – Now when Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, pleading with Him, saying, “Lord, my servant is lying at home paralyzed, dreadfully tormented.” And Jesus said to him, “I will come and heal him.”

Matthew 12:15 – But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and he healed them ALL.

Matthew 12:22 – Then one was brought to Him who was demon-possessed, blind and mute; and He healed him, so that the blind and mute man both spoke and saw.

Matthew 14:14 – And when Jesus went out and saw a great multitude; and *He was moved with compassion for them*, and healed their sick.

Matthew 15:31-31 – Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them. So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

Matthew 19:2 – And great multitudes *followed* Him, and He healed them there.

Matthew 21:14 – Then the blind and the lame *came to Him* in the temple, and He healed them.

Mark 1:32-34 – At evening, when the sun had set, they *brought to Him* all who were sick and those who were demon-possessed. And the whole city was gathered at the door. Then He healed many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons.

Mark 3:10 – For He healed many, so that as many as had afflictions *pressed about Him to touch Him*.

Mark 6:13 – And they cast out many demons and anointed with oil many who were sick, and healed them.

Luke 4:40 – When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and *He laid His hands on everyone one of them* and healed them.

Luke 5:15 – However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and the great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by Him of their infirmities.

Luke 5:17 – Now it happened on a certain day as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. *And the power of the Lord was present to heal them*.

Luke 6:17-19 – And *He came down with them and stood on a level place* with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases, as well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were healed. And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, *for power went out from Him* and healed them all.

Luke 8:43-48 – Now a woman, having a flow of blood for twelve years, who had spent all her livelihood on physicians and could not be healed of any came from behind and touched the border of His garment. And immediately her flow of blood stopped. But Jesus said, "Somebody touched me, for I perceived power going out from me." Now when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling; and falling down before Him, she declared to Him in the presence of all the people the reason she had touched Him and how she was healed immediately. And He said to her, "Daughter be of Good cheer; your faith has made you well. *Go in peace.*"

Luke 9:11 – But when the multitudes knew it, they followed Him; and He received them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who *had need* of healing.

John 5:5-9 – Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity thirty-eight years. When Jesus saw Him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to Him, “Do you want to be made well?” The sick man answered Him, “Sir, there is no one to put me in the pool when the water is stirred up; but while I am coming, another steps down before me.” Jesus said to Him, “Rise, take up your bed and walk.” And immediately the man was made well, took up his bed, and walked.

Healings In the Early Church

Acts 5:16 – And believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, so that they brought the sick out into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them. Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed.

Acts 8:6-7 – And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, hearing and seeing the miracles He did. For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and many who were paralyzed and lame were healed.

Acts 14:9-10 – This man heard Paul speaking. Paul observing him intently and seeing that he had faith to be healed, said with a loud voice, “Stand up straight on your feet!” And he leaped and walked.”

Acts 28:8-9 – And it happened that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and dysentery. Paul went in to him and prayed, and he laid hands on him and healed him. So when this was done, the rest of those on the island who had diseases also came and were healed.
